All US based teams going to Canada for the race at Mosport should be aware that radio usage is regulated by Industrie Canada. You will need to acquire a temporary radio license from Industrie Canada in order to use your two-way radios at the event. The attached paperwork should help accomplish this task in a timely manner with your advance cooperation.

In order to expedite this temporary licensing, please complete two forms and fax to Industrie Canada.

- The “**Short Term Radio License Application**” form should go to the following:

We strongly recommend that all teams start this process immediately in order to have confirmed radio frequencies prior to the event.

## NOTICE TO PARTICIPANTS

### MOSPORT

In Canada, the coordination of radio frequencies and radio systems is managed by Industry Canada Spectrum Management, under the authority of the Radiocommunication Act. If you are planning to install and operate a radio system, including wireless - radio frequency devices at Mosport and do not already hold radio station licences issued by the Minister of Industry for your race at Mosport, the following guidelines are provided:

- Upon the submission of a completed application/spreadsheet along with the appropriate radio licence fees, the Toronto District Office of Industry Canada (see address above) will issue a **Short Term Authority** in advance, for the installation and operation of radio systems during the event.
- The information provided in your application/spreadsheet must be accurate and complete in order that we may co-ordinate and evaluate the radio frequencies to be used during the race, thereby minimizing the possibility of interference between radio systems and existing spectrum users. **Please submit your application/spreadsheet and fees ASAP** to allow us the maximum time to process your frequency request before commencing operation. Please note that the installation or operation of radio apparatus without authority is prohibited under Section 4 of the Radiocommunication Act.
- All applications/spreadsheets will be processed on a “**first come, first served basis**” and all frequency requests are subject to availability. You will be required to accept the licence conditions of “no protection - non interference”, with the understanding that should your system cause harmful interference to other licensed stations, you will be required to either modify your station parameters, i.e. change of frequency or transmitted power, or to cease operation immediately. Also note that the radio authorization must be available for inspection by a Spectrum Management Officer on-site during the event should any issues arise.
- Furthermore, it is advisable that the use of your radio system(s) be limited to your own race event or only as necessary. Your cooperation in the careful use of your radios will further help to minimize the possibility of radio interference.
