Re: Rolex 24 At Daytona and KONI Challenge 3 Hour Drivers

At this time of year, I realize that many of our teams are in the midst of negotiating contracts with their drivers whether it is just for one event or perhaps the entire 2008 season. We understand that this can make things very difficult when it comes time to put driver names on the entry forms for this event if the deals have not yet been finalized.

Please understand that we must have a minimum of two drivers for the KONI Challenge race and a minimum of three drivers listed for the Rolex 24 race in order to complete the processing of your team's entry for these events.

In an effort to help the entry processing run smoothly and eliminate some of the issues regarding driver line-ups for this event, if you are unsure of your drivers at this time, we ask that you do the following:

- List the names of the drivers you intend to have driving the car for this event on the entry form. If you do not want this information released to the public yet, simply put "Do Not Publish" next to their name on the entry form. This way you have met the requirement of completing the entry form and we are able to proceed with the processing of your entry. We will put "TBA" on the preliminary entry list until you either notify us in writing that it is ok to publish the name you have given us or you give us a driver change.

Normally the deadline for the release of driver information is the same date as the entry deadline. We will extend the deadline for publishing the driver names beyond the entry deadline for this event only, until January 9th. The driver information must come from the Team Entrant and all names must be sent in writing to the attention of Cathy Spano. For your convenience, you may email them to her at cspano@grand-am.com or they can be faxed to her attention at (386) 947-6695.

Keep in mind that the drivers you list on the entry forms for the Test Days event will be published on the respective entry lists as those entries are processed. For the Rolex teams, since there is only one entry form that covers both events, this means that **all** driver names listed on your entry form will appear on the January Test Days entry list but those names with the "Do Not Publish" designation beside them will be listed as "TBA" on the Rolex 24 entry list only.

Please adhere to the **January 9th** deadline for releasing driver names and do not make us call and/or email you asking for the information. As I'm sure you are well aware, there are a lot of details for everyone to attend to in preparation for each event and trying to track each person down individually is extremely time consuming.
