TO: All Grand American Entrants

Enclosed you will find a preliminary schedule and an entry form for the Rolex Sports Car Series race at Homestead – Miami Speedway on March 29, 2008. Please take the time to read the contents of this letter as it contains information that will be beneficial to your complete understanding of this event. The entry fees are listed on the entry form.

**NOTE: In accordance with the request of our promoter, we will not accept any entries for drivers who are under the age of 18.**

We will move into the facility on Wednesday, March 26<sup>th</sup>. Thursday is a practice day. Friday is practice and qualifying and Saturday, March 29<sup>th</sup> is the race.

The awards program for this Rolex Series event includes a purse totaling \$250,000.00. Details regarding position awards are included in the enclosed brochure.

**Reminder: There will be no post entry available at the race track. Entries for this event close on February 27th and all entries must be RECEIVED in the Grand American office by that date. All Entry fee checks and charges will be processed as entries are received.**

**In addition, March 10th will be the final day to order Paddock Club meal tickets.** An order form for Paddock Club meal tickets is enclosed. Paddock Club tickets may be ordered in any quantity for one, two or three days. Paddock Club order forms may either be returned with your entry or separately but must be received in the Grand American office by the ordering deadline.

All participants, other than international drivers or entrants, must be members of the Grand American Road Racing Association. Rolex Series drivers or entrants must also be holders of the appropriate FIA license(s). The fee for a Grand American Entrant membership, Driver membership or a Driver/Entrant membership is \$600.00 and includes your annual credential.

International *drivers or entrants* are not required to join Grand American unless they want to earn Grand American championship points or be covered by our insurance. If so, they must also be Grand American members.

The fee for a 2008 FIA Driver or Entrant license is \$225.00 each. Since Grand American is an ACCUS/FIA member organization, you can submit the forms directly to us for processing. The forms are available for printing on our website or by calling 386-681-6355 to have one mailed to you.

Participation in Daytona Prototype requires an "A" or "B" level FIA license. An FIA "B" or "C" license is sufficient for the GT class. Driver applicants are reminded to include their completed physical exam form and the required photograph. This photo is in addition to the one required for Grand American membership.

All entrants must complete and submit a Vehicle Registration Form in order to be assigned a competition number. Vehicle registration is \$500.00 per car. The number you are assigned will remain yours for the balance of the year unless you fail to attend two events in a row. In that case, the number will be made available for reassignment to another car. If your car was not already assigned a scoring transponder during the 2007 season, one must be purchased per vehicle at \$1225.00 each.

The fee for a Grand American general (crew) membership is \$450.00 when combined with the purchase of an annual credential. A single event credential is available for \$85.00, plus a \$65.00 membership if your membership has not already been purchased at an earlier event.

All participants must possess a valid credential to have access to the racetrack. Memberships and credentials will be available at Grand American Registration at the track.

When entries close we will send an acknowledgment, the official supplemental regulations, and an official event schedule to all accepted entrants. We will return all rejected entries immediately, along with the entry fees.
